The Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) presents its compliments to the IAEA's Member States and has the honour to draw their attention to the **Regional School on Nuclear Security for Asia and the Pacific** (hereinafter referred to as "event") which had to be postponed owing to the COVID-19 pandemic and will now be held in Jakarta, Indonesia, from 1 to 12 November 2021.

The purpose of the event is to provide early career professionals from nuclear facilities and other relevant institutions with a basic understanding of nuclear security.

The attached Information Sheet provides further details of the event.

The event will be held in English.

Member States are informed that designations already received for this event will remain valid. Should Member States not have submitted any designations or wish to change their designation, they are invited to designate one or more participants to represent the Government at this event. Member States are strongly encouraged to identify suitable women participants.

The IAEA is generally not in a position to bear the travel and other costs of participants in the event. The IAEA has, however, limited funds at its disposal to help meet the cost of attendance of certain participants. Upon specific request, such assistance may be offered to normally one participant per country, provided that, in the IAEA's view, the participant will make an important contribution to the event. The application for financial support should be made at the time of designating the participants using the attached Grant Application Form (Form C).

It should be noted that compensation is not payable by the IAEA for any damage to or loss of personal property. The IAEA also does not provide health insurance coverage for participants in IAEA events. Arrangements for private insurance coverage on an individual basis should therefore be made. The IAEA will, however, provide insurance coverage for accidents and illnesses that clearly result from any work performed for the IAEA.

Designations should be submitted to the IAEA through the competent national authority (Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Permanent Mission to the IAEA or National Atomic Energy Authority) not later than 1 September 2021 using the attached Participation Form (Form A). Completed and authorized Participation Forms should be sent either by email to: Official.Mail@iaea.org or by fax to: +43 1 26007 (no hard copies needed). The Scientific Secretary of the event will liaise with the participants directly concerning further arrangements, including travel details, as appropriate, once official designations have been received.

# **Information Sheet**

#### Introduction

The Regional School on Nuclear Security offers early career professionals from the Asia and the Pacific region the opportunity to learn, understand and explore a broad spectrum of topics in nuclear security and enhance their skills in the field.

The School will consist of a series of lectures and practical exercises, designed to incorporate the acquired knowledge into national planning and procedures to protect against threats to nuclear security. This School is part of a series of international and regional schools on nuclear security that the IAEA implements in many regions and in a variety of languages.

# **Objectives**

This School is designed to provide early career professionals from the Asia and the Pacific region with the fundamental knowledge of nuclear security necessary to understand the international requirements in this area and the measures to be taken, in order to meet any obligations under the international nuclear security legal framework.

# **Target Audience**

Participants should be early career professionals from the Asia and the Pacific region, ideally with 1-3 years of professional experience, working at an institution within their respective country with responsibilities for ensuring some aspects of nuclear security. Candidates should have a specific interest in pursuing careers which would benefit from knowledge of nuclear security.

# **Working Language**

English

## **Participation and Registration**

All persons wishing to participate in the event have to be designated by an IAEA Member State or should be members of organizations that have been invited to attend.

In order to be designated by an IAEA Member State, participants are requested to send the **Participation Form (Form A)** to their competent national authority (e.g. Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Permanent Mission to the IAEA or National Atomic Energy Authority) for onward transmission to the IAEA by **1 September 2021**. Participants who are members of an organization invited to attend are requested to send the **Participation Form (Form A)** through their organization to the IAEA by above deadline.

Selected participants will be informed in due course on the procedures to be followed with regard to administrative and financial matters.

# **Expenditures and Grants**

No registration fee is charged to participants.

The IAEA is generally not in a position to bear the travel and other costs of participants in the event. The IAEA has, however, limited funds at its disposal to help meet the cost of attendance of certain participants. Upon specific request, such assistance may be offered to normally one participant per country, provided that, in the IAEA's view, the participant will make an important contribution to the event.

The application for financial support should be made using the **Grant Application Form (Form C)** which has to be stamped, signed and submitted by the competent national authority to the IAEA together with the **Participation Form (Form A)** by 1 **September 2021**.

#### Visas

Participants who require a visa to enter Indonesia should submit the necessary application as soon as possible to the nearest diplomatic or consular representative of Indonesia.
