- Operates in close coordination with the International Atomic Energy Agency








ON PEACEFUL USES

 THE ISSUE: barriers remain to nuclear science and technology as a tool for international development, especially among LMICs





 THE STRATEGY: convene individuals from diverse backgrounds in workshops, consultations, and webinars to network and brainstorm solutions at all scales





• THE OUTCOME: expanded network of stakeholders knowledgeable of and benefiting from peaceful nuclear science and technology; ability to connect project ideas with existing funding opportunities







 THE IMPACT: progress towards UN SDGs by expanding access to nuclear technology







Our Approach to Progress

- SDPU activities are **participant driven** and structured around their priorities
- SDPU events are designed to feature technical discussions with tangible, actionable outputs
- The SDPU strives to complement and amplify the work of the IAEA, not duplicate existing efforts

Concentrations Within the SDPU




Food
